School Fees

School fees at Freie Schule Anne-Sophie Berlin is income-based in order to offer lower-income children and young people the opportunity to study at our school.

- ▶ Based on: **total income** (gross) from the tax assessments of both legal guard- ians. Further details can be found in the registration form.
- ▶ In order to comply with the **Sonderungsverbot**, families with an annual family income (gross) of less than 30,000.00 Euros are charged a tuition fee of 100.00 Euros per month for the first child, 75.00 Euros for the second child, 50.00 Euros for the third child and 25.00 Euros for all other siblings. An administrative fee is not charged. The provision of a security service and the service fee do not apply.
- ► Costs for consumables, school clothing, excursions and school trips may be added. If you are financially needy (even if you receive a citizen's allowance), you can apply for a cost reduction or cost absorption.
- ▶ The Würth Foundation can grant a scholarship for families with a notice of receipt of citizen's allowance. In this case, please submit an informal application to the Würth Foundation via the school management.



Administration fee, security deposit

The administration fee of 750.00 Euros and the security deposit of 500.00 Euros are to be paid upon conclusion of the school contract. The security deposit will be refunded after leaving Freie Schule Anne-Sophie Berlin.

Service Fee

A service fee of 100.00 Euro **per year** is charged for the provision of hardware and software and their support.

Catering

All learning partners (students) of Freie Schule Anne-Sophie Berlin are required to participate in lunch. We have our own cook who, together with his staff, prepares fresh food for us every day and offers one vegetarian/vegan dish and one dish with meat (with the exception of Veggie Day on Thursdays) as well as salad and dessert.

▶ Die The catering fee (fresh fruit at breakfast break and all-day drinks) is 75.00 euros per month starting at grade 7. In case of financial need, an application for cost absorption can be made.

Second-hand school clothes

Second hand school clothing can be purchased for a small contribution towards expenses or provided free of charge if financially needy.

Sibling discount

For the first enrolled child in your family, you pay the monthly tuition, which is determined based on your annual gross family income. For the second child you will receive a 20% discount and for the third and each additional child you will receive a 30% sibling discount.

Parental fees for after-school care from 4:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m. (only for elementary school)

Please apply for an after-school care voucher from 4:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m. at the youth welfare office in the district of your residence. Please mark the module from 13:30 to 18:00 on the application. It is then automatically stored in the system that only the time from 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. will be charged. The amount you pay for after-school care is determined by the youth welfare office and is based on your family income, the amount of care provided, and the number of children in the family (based on the Tagesbetreuungskostenbeteiligungsgesetz (TKBG)).



If you reside in the state of Brandenburg, the costs for the after-school care must be requested and applied for individually at the responsible Brandenburg municipality.

Vacation care in the elementary school

If you would like to take advantage of vacation care, we ask that you apply for an after-school care voucher for the vacations. Please note that there will be additional costs depending on your income and that the costs will be determined by the responsible youth welfare office, based on the TKBG.
